Novell[®] Online Documentation is provided to answer your technical questions. The NetWare[®] 4.2 Online Documentation CD-ROM can be viewed directly or accessed as a mounted volume on the network.

PREREQUISITES

If you install the NetWare documentation on a network drive, make sure the workstation is connected to the network.

SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

- A PC with a 386, 486, Pentium, or higher processor
- □ Windows* 95*/98 or Windows NT*
- A CD-ROM drive that can read ISO 9660 formatted CD-ROM disks
- 16 MB RAM

VIEW DOCUMENTATION FROM THE CD-ROM

 From a Windows 95/98 or Windows NT workstation, insert the Online Documentation CD-ROM.

The CD-ROM should auto-launch the Netscape Navigator browser and the Novell Online Documentation.

Note: You can also copy the entire CD-ROM to the network or local disk drive.

2. If the CD-ROM does not auto-launch, run \novdocs\viewdoc.exe.

MOUNT THE CD-ROM AS A VOLUME ON THE NETWORK

- 1. At a NetWare server, insert the *Online Documentation* CD-ROM.
- At the NetWare server console, enter load cdrom.
- 3. Enter cd mount NW42_DOC.
- 4. Continue by accessing the NetWare 4.2 *Online Documentation* CD-ROM as a mounted volume.

ACCESS THE NETWARE 4.2 ONLINE DOCU-MENTATION CD-ROM AS A MOUNTED VOL-UME

- From a Windows 95/98 or Windows NT workstation, map a drive to the volume NW42_DOC.
- 2. From the NW42_DOC volume, run \novdocs\viewdoc.exe.
