Setup Instructions for eHome Infrared Receiver for PC's running under Microsoft® Windows XP Media Center Edition

<u>These instructions work for Microsoft Windows XP Media Center Edition 2005 or higher releases only.</u>

Setup one: Please do the following updates before installing the remote control receiver.

- · Do not plug in the IR Receiver first.
- Download the Hotfix's KB912024 from the CD given as in package or from the website listed as below.
- Run the hotfix KB912024 on your PC.
- Plug in the eHome IR receiver and Windows will automatically detect and install the device.



Setup two: If you have already plugged in the eHome IR Receiver then please do the following steps.


- Install the hotfix as instructed on your CD or website.
- Go to Start → My Computer → Right click → Properties and this will display the system properties window.



• Click on Hardware Tab and click on "Device Manager" button to show all the devices.




- Under the Device Manager → expand "Universal Serial Bus Controllers".
- Right click on "eHome Infrared Receiver" item as shown in the picture.



Click on Update Driver and select "Yes, this time only" radio button and click Next.



Select "Install the software automatically (Recommended)



- Click Next and proceed till the end to install the software and click "Finish" to close the wizard.
- The IR receiver should now be working after all these steps.
