

Simple example for text-decoration

The "text-decoration"-property describes decorations that are added to the text of an element. If the property is specified for a block-level element, it should affect all inline-level descendants of the element (does not work yet!). If it is specified for (or affects) an inline-level element, it affects all boxes generated by the element.

Example: underline

```
<fo:inline text-decoration="underline">underline</fo:inline>
```

The following text decorations are defined in the WD:

- none
- underline
- overline
- line-through
- blink
